

Land Features

This parcel is the southwestern-most part of the Mashpee River Woodlands and has one trail leading to the River. The 11 acre lot was donated to the town in 1994 by Herbert Stenberg who had settled on these acres in 1935. It still borders his original cabin, now a private residence. The donation was aided by the Friends of the Mashpee River. The trail and lot is now dedicated to honor Harry DesRosier who was a member and chairman of the Mashpee Conservation Commission.



Directions (DesRosier Parcel parking) —From the Mashpee rotary take Great Neck Rd South 1.6 miles to the small parking area on the left, just past River Rd (parking lot is directly off Great Neck Rd South).
