


# Town Of Mashpee

Please be it known:

On April 20, 2007, the U.S. Supreme Court reversed its ruling regarding the required use of publicly owned solid waste transfer stations and interstate commerce laws. It is no longer a conflict for the local government to require private haulers to use publicly owned transfer facilities. Therefore, the Board of Health refuse regulation does not violate interstate commerce laws and each licensed hauler shall be required to tip all Mashpee residential and commercial waste at the Upper Cape Regional Transfer Station.
