## **BEFORE THE PUBLIC HEARINGS**

- Petitioners must file Petition with the Town Clerk one copy for the Town Clerk, two copies for the ZBA office.
- Petitioners must submit properly completed Petition forms, plans, and other required documents along with Petition fee to the ZBA office.
- Notice of the Public Hearings is published in the Mashpee Enterprise two consecutive weeks at least two weeks in advance of the Public Hearings.
- ZBA office notifies abutters of the Petition by mail.

## **DURING THE PUBLIC HEARINGS**

- Petitioner or Agent must be present at the Public Hearings to represent Petition.
- After hearing testimony from the Petitioner and/or abutters, the Board renders a Decision on the Petition.

## AFTER THE PUBLIC HEARINGS AND BOARD'S DECISION

- After the Board renders a Decision on the Petition, the Minutes of the meeting are transcribed.
- After transcribing the Minutes, the Decision is composed.
- ZBA office files Decision with the Town Clerk within fourteen days of the Board's final vote on a Petition.
- ZBA office notifies abutters of the Board's Decision by mail.
- After the Decision is filed with the Town Clerk, Massachusetts General Law Chapter 40A Section 17 requires a 20-day Appeal period. This Law is designed to provide any person aggrieved by the Decision the opportunity to Appeal such Decision.
- After the 20-day Appeal period, a copy of favorable Decisions will be certified by the Town Clerk that there has been no Appeal twenty (20) days after the Decision was filed.
- A certified copy of the Decision is issued from the Town Clerk's office.
- A certified copy of the Decision must be recorded at the Barnstable County Registry of Deeds. It is the responsibility of the Petitioner to record a certified copy of the Decision at the Barnstable County Registry of Deeds.
- Once the Decision is recorded at the Barnstable County Registry of Deeds, proof of the recording at the Registry ALONG with the completed Building Permit Application form(s) must be submitted to the Building Department for review.
- After reviewing the Building Permit Application form(s), the Building Department will notify the Applicant as soon as the Building Permit is issued.
