EMAIL PDFs of plan & narrative to conservation@mashpeema.gov 7 copies of project narrative attached describing overall project, adherence to all applicable performance standards (state and local), revisions, reasonable alternatives and construction methodologies. A photocopy of the abutters list as certified by the Mashpee Assessing Department, after completing and submitting (to the Assessing Department) FORM 5 of the SUPPLEMENTAL PACKET OF FORMS TO BE FILLED OUT/SUBMITTED. (Please note: See the Introduction for the Town of Mashpee Conservation Commission Notice of Intent Application Package for more on required certified mail abutters' notice. Check payable to Town of Mashpee: \$200.00. \$400 for After-the-Fact filing.
