CHECKLIST FOR REQUESTING A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

Upon completion of the project, the following shall be submitted to the Conservation Commission in order to receive a Certificate of Compliance:

- a. A WPA form 8A requesting a Certificate of Compliance (COC).
- b. A copy of the **recorded** Order of Conditions and (if applicable) Amended Order of Conditions, Extensions, etc.
- c. A copy of the **plan of record**.
- d. A written statement from a registered professional engineer (for engineered plans) or a written statement from a landscape architect (for landscaping plans) of the Commonwealth certifying that the work has been completed as shown on the plan(s) and documents referenced, and as conditioned by the Commission. This is required ONLY if a project has an engineered plan or professional landscape plan.
- e. The Commission reserves the right, before issuing a Certificate of Compliance (should items a. and b. be deemed insufficient), to require an "as built" plan prepared and signed and stamped by a registered professional engineer or land surveyor of the Commonwealth.
- f. \$150 Certificate of Compliance application fee.

Prior to the scheduled Certificate of Compliance hearing, the Conservation Agent will conduct a site visit to confirm that the project has been completed in compliance with the Plan(s) of record and Order of Conditions.
