Eastern White Pines (Pinus strobus) are one of the most common trees found in our conservation areas. They differ from Pitch Pines (Pinus rigida) in number of needles per bundle (5 in white pine, 3 in pitch) and branch growth (white pines grow in whorls).

This property, shared with the Trustees of Reservations, runs adjacent to Mashpee River. The trail runs through a pine/oak forest, with an incredible understory of huckleberry, inkberry, and sheep laurel. Americorp and our Land Stewards are integral in creating new pathways and maintaining them from 2012 through the present.

Parking: Parking is located at 233 Meetinghouse Road.
