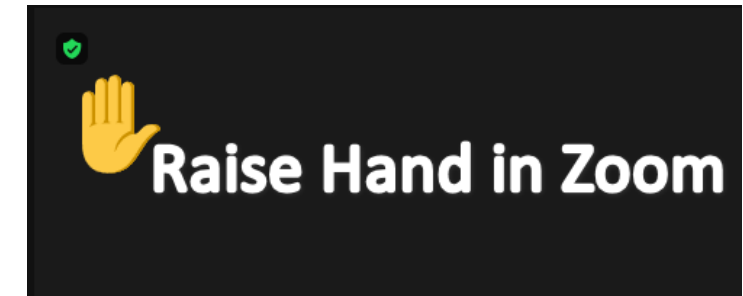
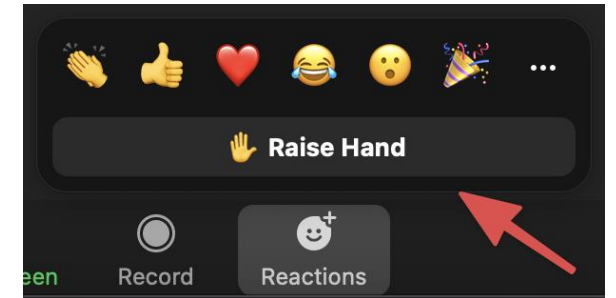

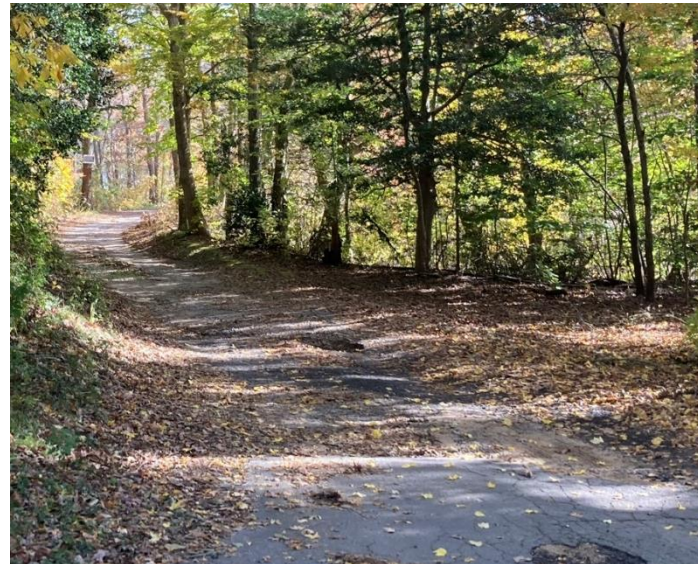
Project Overview

- Experiencing cyanobacteria harmful algal blooms (HABs) – health, habitat, aesthetic impacts
- Expected to increase under future climate (warmer, more rain)
- Nutrient sources for HABs – in pond (sediments) and watershed (stormwater runoff)
- Massachusetts Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness (MVP) Grant
 - FY22 – Identify locations and concepts for stormwater retrofits; retrofit design
 - FY23 – Construct retrofit at Timberlane/Lantern; refine concept for Town Landing



Town Landing – Existing Conditions

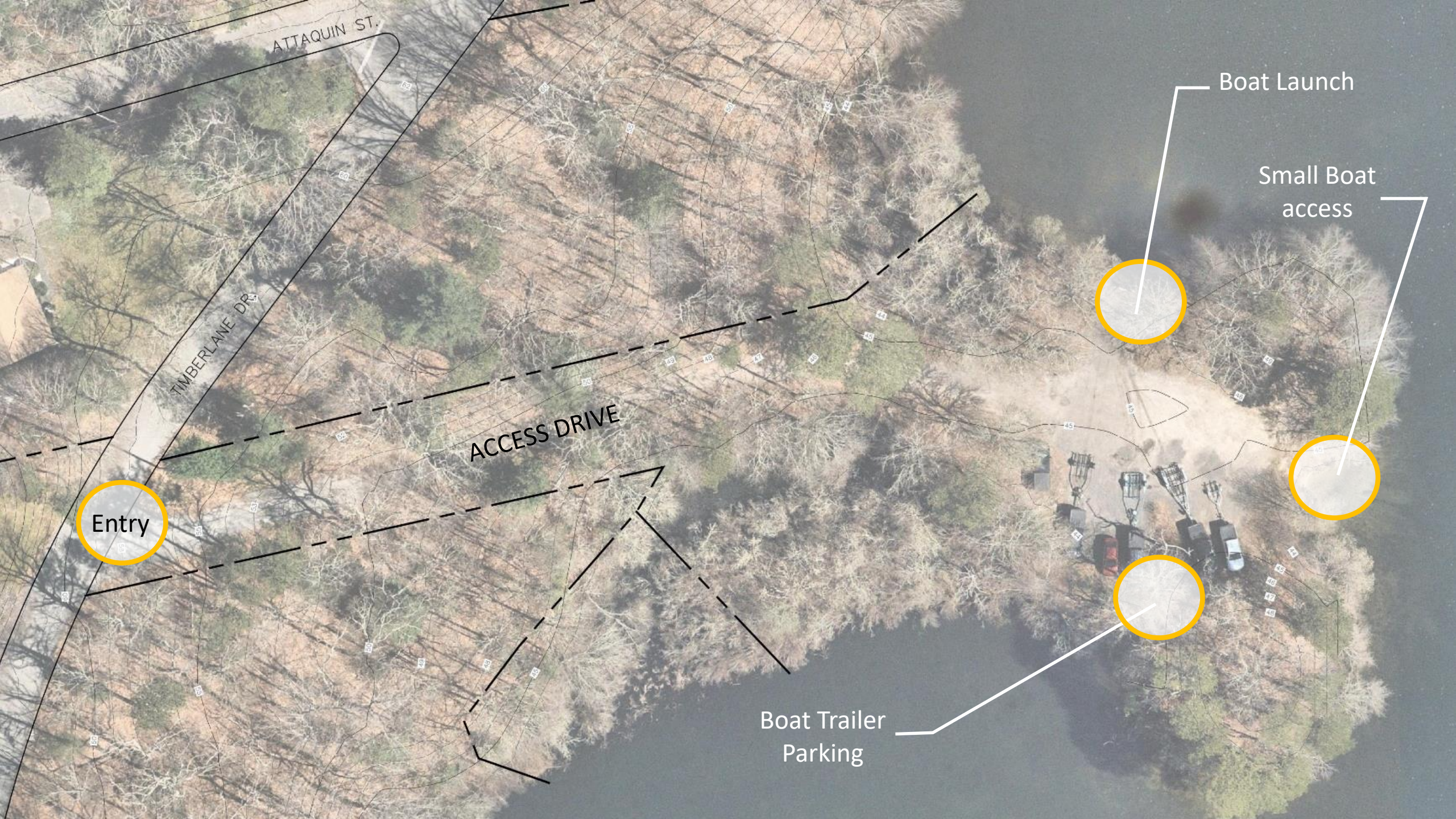
- Town-owned boat launch and fishing area
- Currently experiencing erosion caused by stormwater runoff
- Sediment and nutrient inputs to pond



Project Goals

- Manage stormwater runoff to reduce sediment and nutrient input to Santuit Pond
- Other water quality and ecological improvements – shoreline and wetland
- Promote recreational use – use of non-motorized boats, shoreline fishing, walking trails
- Provide educational features – stormwater quality, water quality, climate change, historical and cultural significance
