#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Wastewater Warrant Article for the May 6, 2024 Annual Town Meeting: Wastewater Ballot Question for the May 11, 2024 Town Election:

The Select Board met in joint convention with the Sewer Commission for the purpose of discussion and possible action on the Wastewater Article for the May 6, 2024 Annual Town Meeting warrant, and the associated Wastewater Ballot Question for the May 11, 2024 Town Election.

In attendance were Sewer Commission members; Chad Smith, Meredith Harris, Catherine Castaneda, Alfred Towle, Joe Lyons, and Phyllis Sprout. Jared Meader; Wastewater Superintendent and representation from GHD, Inc. project engineers were also present for discussion purposes.

Mr. Meader indicated the focus of this meeting is to gain endorsement from the Select Board and Sewer Commission for the passage of the Wastewater Warrant Article and related Ballot Question.

The Wastewater Article proposes to appropriate funds for the implementation and construction of Phase II of the Town's Comprehensive Nitrogen and Wastewater Management Plan for treatment and disposal including the expansion of the Water Resource Recovery Facility adjacent to the Town's solid waste Transfer Station. This project is an initial and essential step in implementing the Town's approved Watershed Nitrogen Management Plan/CWMP which outlines the approaches to meet the Town's nitrogen management goals.

Phase I of the project appropriated \$54 million in October 2022 to begin achieving the goal to remove the septic nitrogen load from Popponesset Bay. The project includes the construction of the Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF) and two sewer service areas.

In March of 2024 plans were released to procure bids for grinder pumps for Phase I and Phase 1A utilizing a \$12 million appropriation. This includes the Phase I collection system streets that were not awarded in 2022.

The following Phase I and Phase IA schedule was outlined:

Phase I Collection System Complete December 2024

Properties Connect to System January into April 2025

WRRF Substantially Complete/Ready for Use May 2025 WRRF Complete July 2025

Phase 1A Complete November 2026

Phase I with Phase IA are anticipated to meet 13% of Mashpee's current nitrogen removal goals for restoring water quality in Popponesset Bay comprised of core central sewer infrastructure with first sections of collection systems.

In Phase II, the service area would be expanded. Areas to be served by sewer include; Popponesset Bay north and south and properties in the Mashpee/Wakeby and Santuit Pond watersheds. The Phase II design is being developed for the collection system, up to 8 pump stations, the addition of new equipment/MBR units to the WRRF to include 4 more open sand beds within the treatment plant.

Expanding the Phase I collection system to the north and south will reduce existing nitrogen loading in Popponesset Bay by an additional 29% for a total reduction of 42% with Phase I and Phase II sewering.

It was disclosed the northern service area would encompass 12.6 miles of pipe, include 5 pump stations servicing 747 parcels. This would remove an estimated 20% of the septic load from the Mashpee River/Popponesset Bay watershed, Mashpee/Wakeby Pond watershed and the Santuit Pond watershed.

The southern service areas are anticipated to meet 9% of the nitrogen removal goals from the Popponesset Bay watershed. This would include 7 miles of pipe, 3 pump stations and service to 393 parcels.

Phase II cost estimates for the \$96.1 million project are outlined as follows;

Collection System North:

Collection System: \$39 million Pump Stations (5): \$11.8 million

Collection System South:

Collection System: \$23 million Pump Stations (3): \$8.2 million

WRRF:

Equipment: \$8.6 million Structures: \$4.1 million Open Sand Beds: \$1.4 million

Total Estimated Cost Phase II: \$96.1 million

Mr. Meader indicated that he is reviewing the possibility of cost saving options as well as additional funding sources. Several cost measures have been identified. This includes reducing the number of pump stations, adding more grinders, refining the force main, pipe routing, lower pressure, removing a lift station, less diameter mains, use of connecting lands, etc.

Phase II is on the DEP Intended Use Plan (IUP) for 2024. With the appropriation of funds in May 2024, the Town is anticipated to accept the DEP 0% interest SRF loan by June of 2024. Construction is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2025.

With the completion of Phase II, the Town would have the sewer infrastructure in place to meet 42% of Mashpee's current nitrogen goals to restore water quality in Popponesset Bay by 2027.

Discussion followed. For clarification it was noted the number of pump stations if reduced as a cost saving measure would not decrease the service areas. Grinder pumps and/or other approaches to serve those areas would be considered as alternatives.

Although there are parcels closer to the water that should be considered, those are in the plan for additional service areas in the future if needed. The goal of this project is to maximize the number of parcels that would flow by gravity within the capacity of the WRRF.

It was affirmed the project will be successful and the cost would remain steadfast at the \$96.1 million projection. It is anticipated that a presentation with options would be readily available for the May 2024 Town Meeting.

It was suggested the Town seek designation as an Environmental Justice community to open the door for additional revenue streams, and priority projects.

The implementation of this project is consistent with the 2015 Nitrogen Manager Plan of the Town and dedicated to Option 9 as approved by the Select Board and Sewer Commission. With a 0% interest SRF loan, contributions from the Cape & Islands Water Protection Fund, principal forgiveness, the Wastewater Infrastructure Fund (WIIF) and the Wastewater Stabilization Fund it is projected the debt service to be paid by the taxpayers is 71.7%.

Town Manager Rodney C. Collins respectfully requested the Select Board and Sewer Commission act on the Town Meeting warrant article and the associated ballot question. To adhere to posting requirements, the warrant is scheduled to be finalized by the Select Board on March 18, 2024.

The Town Manager and Wastewater Superintendent were highly acknowledged as was the project engineers of GHD, Inc. for their professionalism. There is assurance the subsidies would be realized.

It was noted that other practices such as stormwater reduction and use of fertilizer would be strongly considered in the nitrogen reduction plan to achieve clean waters and TMDL compliance.

The Select Board acting as the Local Licensing Authority for the Town of Mashpee opened the Public Hearing on the application of Abdul Hafeez Mian d/b/a Mashpee Country Store, 387 Main Street, Mashpee. Said premise is described as the first floor of a one-story wood frame building containing approximately 2,168 square feet, with two entrances and exists on the west side of the building; sales area approximately 2,168 square feet having a delicatessen, counters, and deli units; coffee bar and grocery shelves, two bathrooms in rear with unfinished basement having approximately 2,168 square feet.

Paul Tarif representing counsel addressed the Select Board on behalf of Abdul Hafeez Mian, Manager. Attorney Tarif indicated the subject establishment maintains an Annual Wine & Malt Package Store License without incident. Several patrons have requested the establishment offer seasonal all alcohol beverages. As per MGL Chapter 138, it is permissible for a licensee to hold both an Annual Wine and Malt License and a Seasonal All Alcohol License provided they operate from the same location.

Mr. Mian was noted to have the qualifications, with cameras and a check system in place. The Seasonal All Alcohol License would be maintained only during the established time frame for seasonal alcohol licenses and removed from site thereafter. Due to the seasonal population estimate, there are three available Seasonal All Alcohol Package Store Licenses available currently.

DPW Director Catherine Laurent: Recommendations for Award of the Following Contracts:

# HVAC Upgrades at the KC Coombs School:

Catherine Laurent, Director of Public Works was in attendance to recommend the Select Board award a contract to Performance Plumbing & Heating, Inc. of Medway, MA in the amount of \$1,518,824 for HVAC upgrades to the Kenneth C. Coombs School. The quote includes fees for the required filed sub-bids.

Ms. Laurent indicated that this firm was the lowest most responsible bidder for the project. The firm is DCAMM certified receiving a 93% evaluation rating for completed projects. With approval it is anticipated that work would begin in late June after the school term with project completion in the fall.

Owner's Project Manager (OPM) Services for Mashpee School HVAC Projects:

It is the recommendation of the DPW Director to award a Negotiated Contract Fee for the Owner's Project Manager (OPM) Services for Mashpee School HVAC projects. The fee shall not exceed \$285,000. The reimbursement limit is up to \$8,000 for use of an online bidding service, and the reimbursement limit of up to \$20,000 is limited for an independent estimating firm to prepare a construction estimate. The Town will work on the selection of an engineer/designer, and in moving forward to construction at the two schools.

Anser Advisory of Boston, MA is the recommended OPM. Payment would be made on a monthly basis based on actual hours worked for the project team members. The OPM is required by State statute. The proposed project term is March 18, 2024 through December 31, 2025.

It is likely the Town would receive rebates to offset costs.

The scope of services does not include a Clerk of the Works.

Earth Day Atlantic White Cedar Tree Planting: Sunday, April 21, 2024, 1-3 pm, Santuit Pond Preserve: Daniel Kent, Assistant Conservation Agent:

Daniel Kent, Assistant Conservation Agent reviewed the Earth Day Atlantic White Cedar Tree Planting planned at the Santuit Pond Preserve on Sunday, April 21, 2024 from 1-3 p.m.

The objective is to rejuvenate the area's ecosystem by planting Atlantic White Cedar trees in an abandoned cranberry bog located at the southern end of Santuit Pond. The public is invited to join in the planting of 100 trees across select sections of the 1.5-acre bog to revitalize the Santuit Pond Preserve.

Applicable regulatory officials have signed off on the Special Events Application. With the Select Board's approval, the Conservation Commission is required to approve the planting as any abandoned cranberry bog is considered a wetland. The Town at present, is partnering with a local non-profit to purchase the trees.

It was suggested that additional grant funding be applied for to restore abandoned bogs to wetlands to create peat bog ecology for the filtration of impurities. It was noted that currently, interns are collecting Atlantic White Cedar seed for future plantings. Presentation: Cape Cod Regional Technical High School Fiscal Year 2025 Budget: Cape Cod Regional Technical High School Business Administrator Erin Orcutt:

Erin Orcutt, Business Administrator for the Cape Cod Regional Technical High School was in attendance to update the Select Board on the FY2025 budget. Overall, the enrollment from the twelve participating towns has decreased by two with a total enrollment of 662 students. A total of 55 students from the Town of Mashpee are enrolled in the FY2025 program compared to 50 students attending in FY2024. This represents 8.3% of the FY2025 enrollment from Mashpee.

Ms. Orcutt indicated that 457 applications were received for the incoming class. Over 180 students were accepted into the FY2025 program.

The \$17,484,000 school budget has increased by 4.38% or \$734,000. Teacher salaries comprise the largest portion of the budget at 35.1%. Insurance benefits amount to 11.2% of the total budget with support services totaling 9.4% and plant operations consuming 9.2% of the funds. Ms. Orcutt indicated that state of the art facilities is difficult and costly to maintain.

Cape Cod Regional Technical High School Business Administrator Erin Orcutt: (continued)

In FY2019 the Cape Cod Technical School issued a bond in the amount of \$68,985,000 at 3.32% for the new facility. The 20-year bond with fixed principal is due to expire in 2039. The FY2025 capital debt assessment to the Town of Mashpee is \$476,292. The increase is due to the 5 additional students.

With the capital assessment of \$476,292 and the operating assessment of \$1,142,273 the total estimated assessment for FY2025 for the Town of Mashpee is \$1,618,565.

In closing, it was noted that \$300,000 is funded each year for the Other Post Employment Benefits (OPEB). The balance of the OPEB Reserve is \$2,278,387. The net position of funding to liability is 14.35%. The Cape Cod Technical School was noted to have joined the Plymouth County OPEB Trust in 2015. The investment pool is strong as it is comprised of other counties. The fees are reasonable and the earnings have been substantial.

Discussion followed with respect and concern to the rising costs associated to the school budget.

Ms. Orcutt indicated there are no plans to increase staffing significantly. Any revenue that is returned is used as an offset for student supplies and materials. The school has a robust community program. Some of which is free for the unemployed, and grant funded by the Workforce Investment Board and other lease agreements such as the YMCA that generate revenue. Earlier this year (January), the Secretary of State authorized the mailing of the Vote-By-Mail cards to each and every voter in the Commonwealth. On the card, the voter was afforded the opportunity to choose which Federal/State election ballot they wished to receive by mail. By choosing the "All Elections" category, unbeknownst to the voter, this now guaranteed that the voter would also receive, via mail, an Early Vote-By-Mail ballot for the May 11, 2024 Annual Town Election. To date we have received, and are still receiving, over 3,320 Presidential Primary ballots from Mashpee voters.

At the March 5, 2024 Presidential Primary, 4,481 voters cast a ballot either by mail, In-Person Early Voting, or on Election Day. While it is difficult to determine how many voters returned their Vote-By-Mail ballots, I am mandated to mail a ballot to each and every one of those voters.

On Tuesday, March 19, 2024, the Mashpee Board of Registrars convened in regular session to discuss offering voters the opportunity to cast a ballot early, in-person. This is a request that requires both the Registrars' vote to recommend and the Select Board to approve for each and every local election. At their meeting on the 19<sup>th</sup>, the Registrars unanimously voted to recommend the Select Board offer Mashpee voters the opportunity to cast their ballots early at Town Hall, beginning April 29, 2024 through May 3, 2024. The hours of Early Voting In-Person will be 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. At this time I would ask the Select Board to vote to offer Early Voting In-Person during this time period.

Finally, attached for your approval is the election warrant for the May 11, 2024 Annual Town Election. Since the May 11, 2024 Annual Town Election is not only on a Saturday but also Mother's Day weekend, I would ask that the Select Board vote to operate the election from 9 am to 3 pm on May 11<sup>th</sup>. We are offering voters a plethora of ways to vote, thereby eliminating the need to hold the election from 7 am to 8 pm.

Title to the "tax parcels" was now vested in Josephine D. Mills.

The remaining locus parcels were conveyed by Clinton E. Lawrence to Elwood O. Mills, by deed dated May 11, 1960, recorded in Book 1077, Page 587 117. Lawrence conveyed all of his right, title and interest in the land shown on "Plan of Santuit Park" recorded in Plan Book 27, Plan 37 (the plan reference is frequently incorrectly referenced as Plan 37 but the correct Plan number is 137). Harriet E. Lawrence signed the deed, to "release to said grantee all right of dower and homestead and other interest therein." As title to this land was not vested in Clinton E. Lawrence but was instead vested in Harriet E. Lawrence, by deed from Fred H. Goss dated September 12, 1912, recorded in Book 317, Page 201 130b, this land was the subject of an action to quiet title in Barnstable Superior Court No. 08-700 130. The Judgment dated October 14, 2009 found that there was an unrecorded deed from Harriet E. Lawrence to Clinton E. Lawrence for all her right, title and interest in the Santuit Park land and that Elwood O. Mills obtained good title from Clinton E. Lawrence in the deed recorded in Book 1077, Page 587 117 and title to the lots described in that deed were free and clear of any claims of the heirs of Harriet Lawrence.

M.G.L. Chapter 240, Section 10 recites that a judgment establishing or declaring the validity, nature or extent of the plaintiff's title may be entered and "shall operate directly on the land and have the force of a release made by or on behalf of all defendants of all claims inconsistent with the title established or declared thereby." Therefore, Elwood O. Mills' title to the Santuit Park lots conveyed by deed recorded in Book 1077, Page 587 117 was not defective.

Elwood O. Mills and Josephine D. Mills conveyed all of their right, title and interest in land known as Santuit Park and shown on Plan 27-37, "containing 93 lots more or less" to Josephine D. Mills by deed dated July 21, 1980, recorded in Book 3129, Page 123 <u>118</u>. Neither this deed nor the prior deed recorded in Book 1077, Page 587 identifies the lot numbers of the parcels conveyed. I have assumed the lot numbers recited in the subsequent deed from Josephine D. Mills recorded in Book 15578, Page 33, see below, which make reference to the deed recorded in Book 3129, Page 123 clarifies this ambiguity.

Josephine D. Mills conveyed a portion of the land in Book 3129, Page 123, Assessors parcels 108-115, Lots 557, 559-589 on Plan 27-137 to Elwood Oakley Mills, Jr. by deed dated October 25, 1980, recorded in Book 3191, Page 120 <u>119</u>.

Josephine D. Mills conveyed all of the locus lots, except those previously conveyed to Elwood Oakley Mills, Jr. and also excepting Lots 547-550, to Emma-jo Ann Mills Brennan by deed dated September 10, 2002, recorded in Book 15578, Page 33 <u>125</u>, Parcels 1, 2 and 3. Josephine D. Mills retained a life estate in these parcels.

Josephine D. Mills died testate, January 9, 2003, Barnstable Probate No. 10P0151 <u>128</u>. She predeceased her husband Elwood O. Mills who died April 9, 2006, but her estate was not probated until 2010 and at that time her only heirs were her children, Elwood O. Mills, Emma Jo Ann Mills Brennan and Jeffrey A. Mills. She devised her estate to the

Josephine Mills Trust and Elwood O. Mills, Jr. was appointed Executor with power to sell. Her Inventory listed 4 unbuildable lots, 547-550 off Chopchaque Road, Mashpee.

Elwood O. Mills, Jr. conveyed non-locus parcels to Emma-jo Ann Mills Brennan by deed dated June 17, 1999, recorded in Book 12347, Page 135 <u>123</u>.

Elwood Oakley Mills, Jr., individually and as Executor of the Estate of Josephine D. Mills by power of sale in the will and Emma-Jo Ann Mills Brennan conveyed to the Town of Mashpee, for open space, conservation and passive recreation purposes, by deed dated May 2, 2010, recorded in Book 24535, Page 313 133, the lots shown on Plan 27-137 and described as 16 parcels. The deed to the Town of Mashpee included all right, title and interest to take sand and soil from lots in Santuit Park. The deed also conveyed rights in "paper" roads, specifically, Lowell Street, Coolidge Street, Harlow Street, Tobey Street, Abbotsford Road, Lake Avenue, Fuller Street, Englewood Avenue, Dale Street and Chopchague Road on Plan 27-137, subject to the right of others in said ways.

Josephine D. Mills conveyed to Chop Chaque Cranberries, Inc., non locus parcels by deed dated February 5, 1996, recorded in Book 10044, Page 261 <u>120</u>. Chop Chaque Cranberries, Inc. conveyed to Elwood O. Mills, Jr., by deed dated February 2, 1996, recorded in Book 10044, Page 263 <u>122</u>, "any and all rights to take sand and soil from" land shown on Plan 27-137 excepting land conveyed to the grantor by deed dated February 5, 1996, recorded in Book 10044, Page 261. Sand rights were not a part of this title examination and this certification excludes any rights regarding the taking of sand and soil from the locus parcels.

Locus is subject to the declaration in the deed to the Town of Mashpee that it be used for open space, conservation and passive recreation purposes. Any conveyance from a municipality must be accompanied by a clerk's certificate giving evidence of the authority by which the grant is made.

Locus is also subject to an Order of Resource Area Delineation by the Mashpee Conservation Commission recorded in Book 12788, Page 280 <u>124</u>. Although the applicant is Cotuit Golf Development Co. LLC, the locus parcels are affected by this instrument.

Locus is also subject to the rights of others in portions of locus located within the bounds of the "paper" streets shown on Plan 27-137 and rights of others over "Ex. Traveled Way" shown on Plan 665-43 4.
