SUBJECT:

Recommendations for Award of Contract for Salt and Agricultural By-Product

The Town solicits bids for the purchase of salt and agricultural by-product (SafeMelt) through a regional bid with the other municipalities in the Counties of Barnstable and Plymouth. Bids were opened on September 21<sup>st</sup>. Attached are the results.

I recommend that a contract be awarded to Eastern Minerals, Inc. who submitted the lowest qualified bid of **\$68.50 per ton**. This is approximately a 10% decrease from FY23.

I am also recommending that a contract be awarded to **Morton Salt** for pre-treated salt. They submitted the lowest qualified bid of **\$84.13 per ton**. As the name suggests, this salt is delivered already treated with the agricultural by-product. This provides DPW with an option when either time doesn't permit DPW to pre-treat ourselves and/or the agricultural by-product isn't available.

Finally, I recommend that a contract be awarded to **Safe Road Services** and G.B. Sons Construction Co., Inc. who both submitted the lowest qualified bid of **\$2.30 per gallon** (2,000 – 4,000 gallons). This is a 33% increase from FY23.
