

SUBMERGED DREDGE PIPE

THE COUNTY DREDGE HAS COMPLETED THE DREDGING OF THE APPROACH CHANNEL. AS DETAILED IN THE CHART BELOW, THERE ARE TWO SECTIONS OF **16** INCH HARD PLASTIC PIPE SUBMERGED TO THE SOUTH/SOUTHWEST OF THE POPPONESSET SPIT IN SHALLOW WATER.

MARINERS ARE URGED TO EXERCISE CAUTION WHEN BOATING IN THIS AREA.



There is a total of ~4,800' feet of pipe in two sections (~3,200' & ~1,600') submerged in approximately 5' of water just south of the Popponesset Spit. There are Orange & White Poly Balls marking the location of the end of the pipe & anchor at each end. There is also a second Poly Ball marking the mid-points of each pipe.

The pipe is 'loaded' with ~25% sand to keep it in position. The pipe is being stored here on a temporary basis and will be moved to another location within the next 4 weeks.
