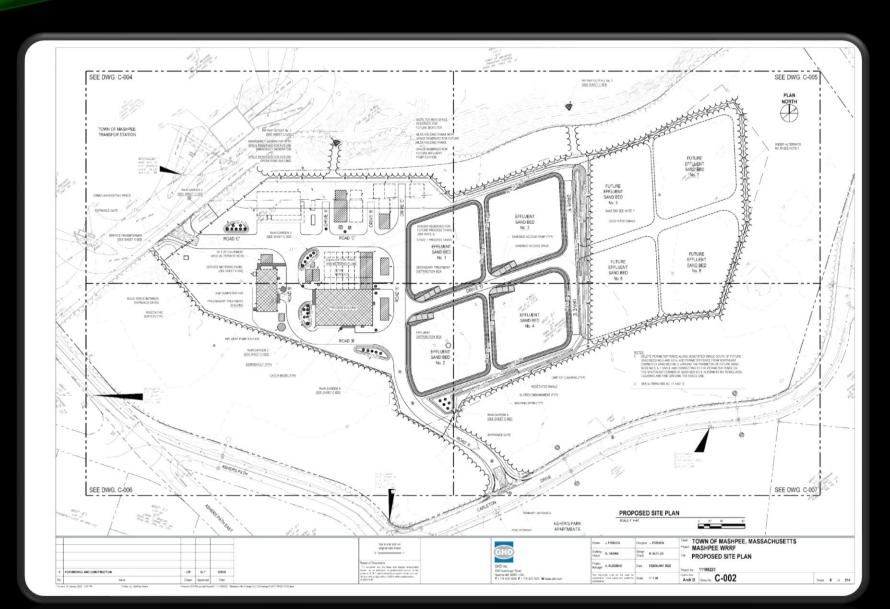

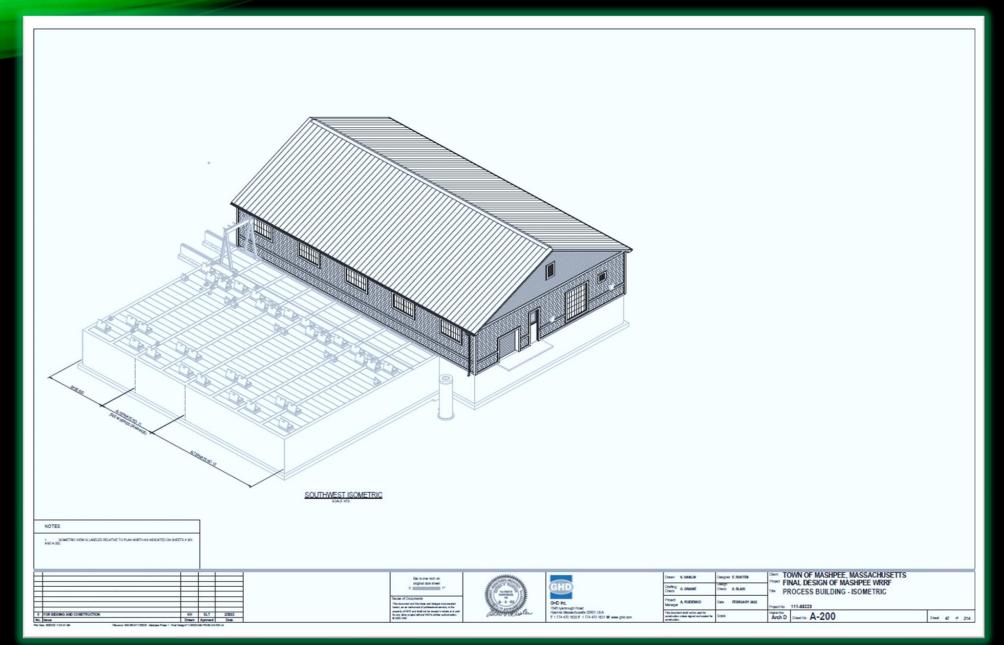




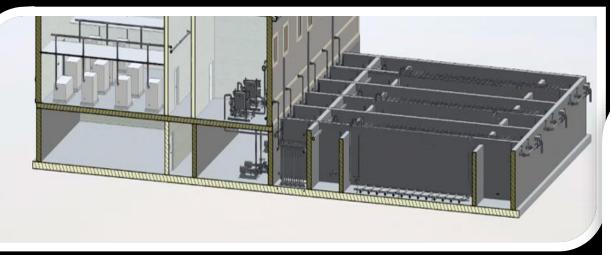
MASHPEE WRRF SITE – CONTRACT #1

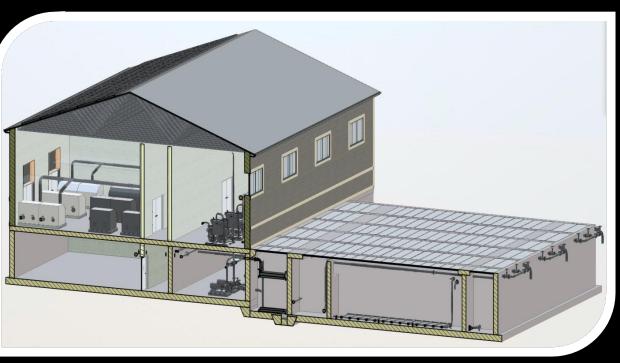


WRRF TANK ISOMETRIC

PROBLEM IS:

- 12 Alternate Bid items listed
- Can only award:
 - Base bid (includes 2 process tanks) \$26.727M
 - Alternate 1 Carbon Scrubber (Odor Control polish unit) \$280K
 - Alternate 2 2 additional process tanks \$956K
 - Can't award Alternate 3 remaining 4 tanks \$1.676M
 - Represents high-cost risk if delayed
 - Extensive construction / excavation on a new plant

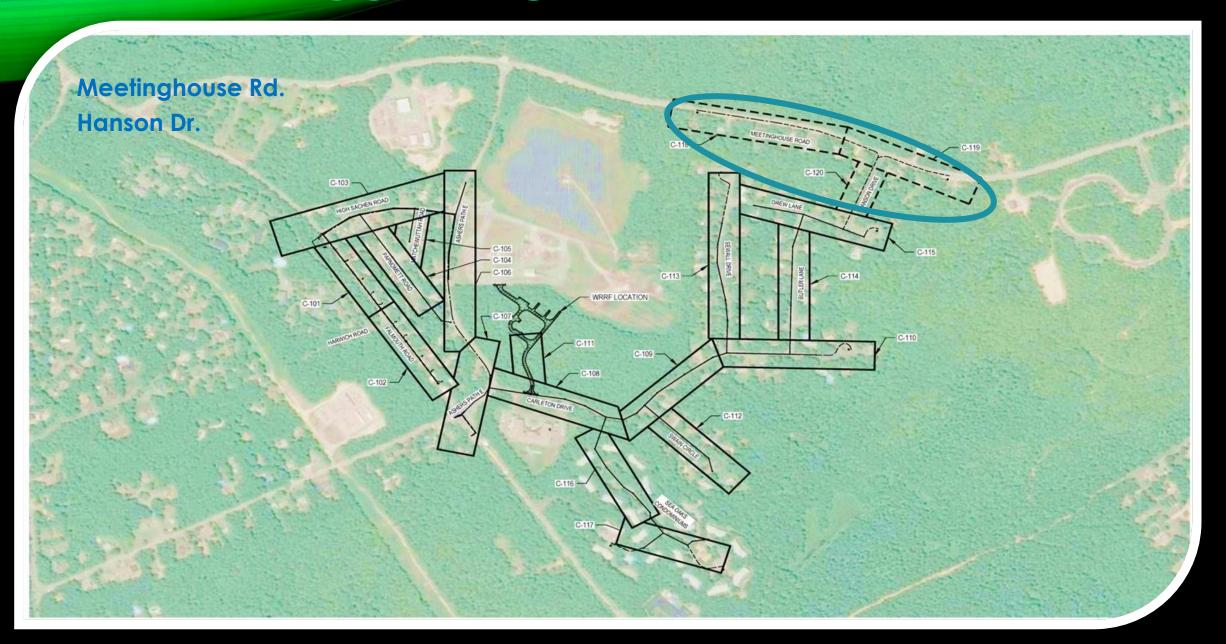

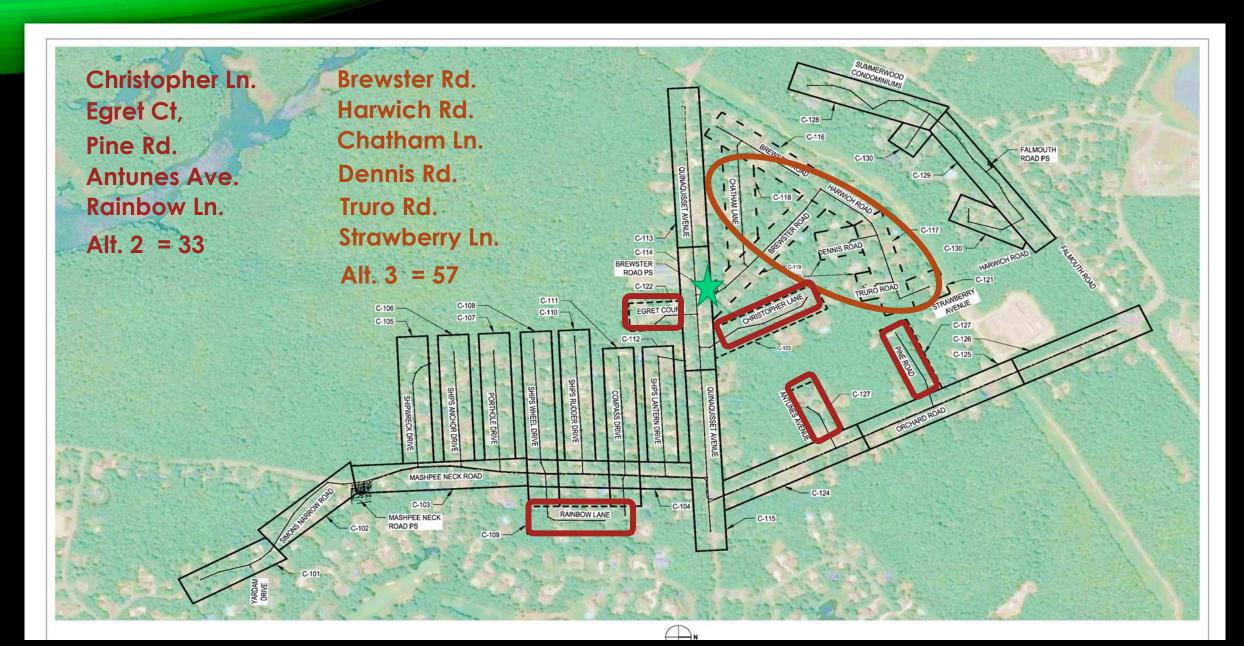

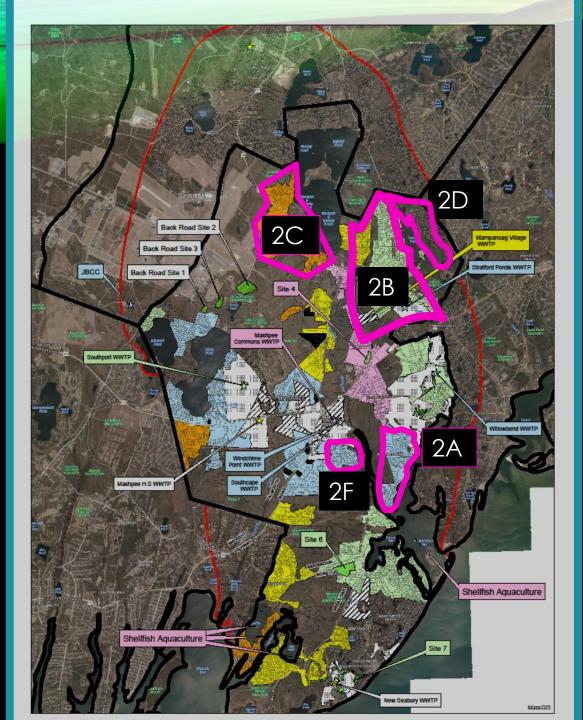

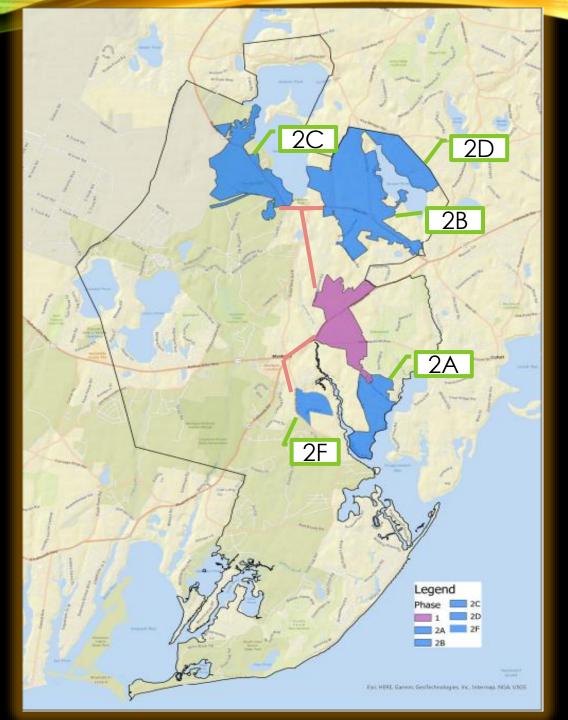

PHASE PLAN RE-EVALUATION

- NOPC (Notice of Project Change): Required by MEPA Certificate
 - Re-evaluates existing plan Adaptive Management approach
 - Shellfish propagation efficacy, sewering effort, stormwater mgt., fertilizer mgt.
 - Revises phasing as necessary
 - 7 years since 2015 Plan
 - Provides cost estimates for all Phase Areas (existing or modified)
 - Includes Phase 2A, B, C, D, & F
 - Allows for financial planning Operations & Capital
 - Allows for on-site system (Title V, I/A's) planning based on sewer plan
 - Results in updated SewerCAD model
 - 1st step toward obtaining DEP Watershed Permit
 - 1st step toward design / SRF Loan (PEF & IUP)
 - Evaluation / Analyses /Costing Not design
 - 2-year effort
 - Requested ARPA funding level = \$250K
 - Recommended for approval.
