Good afternoon Mr. Lehrer,

I am wanting to know the exact number, size and location of "satellite" transmitters/receivers necessary to give complete coverage to the area of concern if a 150' monopole is erected at Red Brook Road. There has been mention a scant few times of their necessity, but I don't recall actual numbers and locations being discussed. I am especially interested to know if placing those satellites where they are needed will present legal concerns. I am assuming The Town's goal is to have complete coverage at our southern end once all work is completed. Perhaps you could ask this question of the developer tonight.

Also (and this may be more of a legal question), can you tell me if Blue Sky was asked to solve the problem from the Red Brook Road location, or if they were only asked to solve the coverage concern in southern Mashpee, without regard for a preferred location? Phrased differently, could the town have put out an RFP without specifying a location that the town owned?

Lastly, are there any other town-owned lots in southern Mashpee (other than the town beach), or other locations that could be expropriated that are large enough to site a tower?
